5 BEYOND: THE COMMUNITY OF PRACTICE

CULTIVATE WILL:

- nurture the transition towards more sustainable food systems by raising awareness of food sharing initiatives and strengthening sustainable food sharing.
- develop the Food Sharing Compass, a social innovation support platform consisting of 5 tools which will be tested in three hub cities and replicated in six spoke locations across the EU.
- assist cities and stakeholders in navigating towards resilient and sustainable food sharing through the Food Sharing Compass tools.
